<b>Departure point and time:</b>	8.20am via bus from Winmalee High School or students can make their own way and meet at the venue at 8.30am.
<b>Method of transport:</b>	Buses will be provided for students who are unable to travel to the venue independently, otherwise students can meet at the venue at 8.30am.
<b>Cost:</b>	For students catching the bus - \$12.00 for bus and pool entry (paid when boarding the bus). For students meeting at the venue - \$6.00 for pool entry (paid upon entrance at the front gate)
<b>Supervising Teacher(s):</b>	All teachers will be supervising at the carnival

## SCHOOL CARNIVAL PERMISSION NOTE 2021

An excursion has been arranged for your child to attend the *School Cross Country Carnival*

- Date:** Wednesday, 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021
- Venue:** Blue Gum Swamp Fire Trail
- Activities to be undertaken:** Winmalee High School Cross Country Carnival
- Departure point and time:** The day will commence as usual with roll call at 8.30am followed by period 1 as a normal lesson. Students will leave school grounds at approximately 10.20am and will return by 2.30pm. Students will be dismissed at 2.30pm
- Method of transport:** Students and teachers will be walking from school to Blue Gum Swamp fire trail. Students will then run or walk the set cross country distance for their age group, record their names at the checkpoint and proceed to walk the remaining fire trail they reach the end of the track. Students will then walk back to school under the supervision of teachers.
- Cost:** No cost is involved
- Supervising Teacher(s):** All teachers will be supervising the carnival
- Emergency contact number:** 47542822
- Dress:** School PE / Sport uniform is to be worn all day
- Lunch:** Students are advised to take water and some food in a small backpack. There will be some water available for students running the track. There will be some food stalls and a BBQ available at school and the canteen will also be open when students return to school.

At the end of recess students will assemble at designated points within the school according to their age group. Staff will supervise the groups walking from school to the end of White Cross Rd where the Cross Country begins. Staff will also supervise students along the track and on the return to school. Students must wait at each street crossing and must cross under instructions from the staff. Students have the option of completing the Cross-Country track as walkers or runners.

Races will start at approx. 11am and will follow sequence listed below:
