An excursion has been arranged for your child to attend the School Cross Country Carnival

Date: Wednesday, 31st March 2021

Activities to be undertaken: Winmalee High School Cross Country Carnival

Departure point and time: The day will commence as usual with roll call at 8.30am followed by period 1 as

a normal lesson. Students will leave school grounds at approximately 10.20am

and will return by 2.30pm. Students will be dismissed at 2.30pm

Method of transport: Students and teachers will be walking from school to Blue Gum Swamp fire trail.

Students will then run or walk the set cross country distance for their age group, record their names at the checkpoint and proceed to walk the remaining fire trail they reach the end of the track. Students will then walk back to school under the

supervision of teachers.
