- basic starter subject books. This included 5 books for subjects such as English, Geography, Science, History etc as well as providing a gridbook provided for maths and a music book.
- a maths protractor set.
- a scientific calculator.

These backpacks were presented to the students this week. We wish them and all our students transitioning to high school next year all the very best for their future studies and learning opportunities.
