Time *Doors open 4:30 p.m. for a 5:30 p.m. start – finish approx 8.30 p.m.*
Venue *Ken Rosewall Tennis Centre, Rod Laver Drive Homebush Bay 2127*
Cost *\$9.00 per person - (including children competing)*
Transport *We have booked a bus as an option to transport students to the venue. It will leave school at 4:00pm. Children can either stay at school supervised by St Anthony's staff until 4:00pm and travel by bus OR parents can drive their child to the venue and meet us there by 5:00pm at the latest. **Parents/families can meet us at the venue but must transport their children home after the event.***

TICKETING – Tickets will now be pre-sold and allocated seats can be purchased online through trybooking.com - **TICKETS ON SALE MONDAY 15th MARCH 2021 - 9am.**

1. Participating students – tickets purchased via Try Booking. The children will be seated within their school area.
2. Parents and Spectators – tickets purchased via Try Booking. These tickets are ALLOCATED seats and a certain number of seats are available directly behind your children's school.

Once these tickets are sold, there are additional ALLOCATED seats available at either end of the Arena.
