## Uniform Procedures

Every student at Stockton Public School is expected to wear the school uniform.

The wearing of school uniforms by students will assist school communities in:

- defining an identity for the school within its community
- developing students' sense of belonging to the school community
- providing an opportunity to build school spirit
- enhancing the health and safety of students when involved in school activities
- promoting a sense of inclusiveness, non-discrimination and equal opportunity
- reinforcing the perception of the school as an ordered and safe environment
- increasing the personal safety of students and staff by allowing easier recognition of visitors and potential intruders in the school
- promoting positive community perceptions of public education
- making school clothing more affordable for families by eliminating the risk of peer pressure to wear transiently fashionable and expensive clothes.

### Implementation:

- The school uniform applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports shorts are available and are required to be worn.
- Minimal jewellery is allowed. Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches are the only acceptable jewellery.
- Hair accessories should be navy blue.
- Makeup is not to be worn to school at any time. This includes fake nails and nail polish.
- School hats are to be worn at all times in the playground, for sport and on excursions as part of the no hat/no play policy and keeping with the Sun Smart guidelines.
- The school office staff operate a uniform shop as well as a second hand uniform pool for parents.
- The Principal and staff are responsible for the implementation of the school uniform in a manner consistent with the Core Rules for students in NSW Government Schools.
- Sports shorts can be worn on days classes have sport or PE and at all school sporting carnivals and events.
- Skorts and shorts should be at least mid thigh in length
- Notes will be sent home to inform parents of breaches of the uniform procedures. Repeated breaches will be dealt with in accordance with the school Discipline Procedures.

The following items are not part of the Stockton Public School Uniform and are not to be worn to school:

- Long socks – white or black
- Black or white skate/surf socks
- Non-school coloured or oversized hair accessories (E.g. Jo Jo Bows)
- Black tights or leggings
- Navy leggings
- Football / netball/soccer club sloppy joes
