Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Stage 3 curriculum, we have organised for the children to participate in a Claymation Digital Animation Workshop. This activity will be for Year 5 and Year 6 students only.

This workshop allows students, using the stopmotion / claymation process, to story board, animate (using the latest digital software), edit (adding of titles, credits & music etc) and produce an animation. All material is provided. Students develop their narrative writing skills, work with multimodal digital media, explore the Science & Technology syllabus strand "Information & Communications" and utilise aspects from the Creative Arts syllabus.

A brief overview of the incursion -

- Date: The Claymation workshop is a whole day activity at school. It is organised for three consecutive Fridays, Friday 28 May, Friday 4 June and Friday 11 June. The Stage 3 teachers will split the students into three groups, it may not be the class group. Each group will attend one of the Friday sessions. As the workshop gets closer students will be notified of the Friday that they will be attending.
- Venue: School hall
- Cost: \$35.00 per student
- Due date: Friday 21 May
