- **Date:** Friday 14th May
- **Venue:** Corroba Oval
- **Departure time:** 9:30am
- **Time returning to school:** 2:45-3pm
- **Transport:** Bus
- **Equipment needed:** Lunch/recess, sunscreen, water bottle, asthma medication.
- **Uniform:**

The school is funding the cost of the buses to transport students to and from Corroba Oval. All students must **come to school as usual**. Classroom teachers will mark the roll in classrooms. Students will travel by bus to and from the oval. Please ensure your child is at school prior to 9am.

Parent Information Sheet

Whilst at the Sports Carnival the children are under the supervision of the teachers and must sit in the designated areas. This is for child protection and duty of care reasons.

Schedule of events

- Events include - 100m
 - 200m
 - 800m
 - shot put
 - long jump
 - high jump (for students 8-12)
 - relays
 - various novelty events.
- We will start with the 800m and then the 200m for both Juniors (8,9,10 year olds) and Seniors (11 and 12 year olds). While these events are running, 5-7 year old will be participating in some other group activities.
- This year all running events will be timed heats. There will be no Finals.
- After lunch, students will be split into their age groups and will rotate through novelty events, field events (shot put, high jump, long jump) as well as their 100m age race.
- After rotations have finished, we will hold Junior and Senior Relays, if time permits.

Lunch

- There will be a lunch break when students can sit with parents in their House area.
- **Please note** there will be no sausage sizzle as in past years. All students must bring all of their food with them as there is no provision for food available. Please pack a couple of water bottles in your child's bag. Your child will be active and the weather could be warm.

What to wear

- Hats and joggers are a must. Please label everything. Children are encouraged to wear a t-shirt in their house colour (e.g. red shirt for Scott, blue for Selwyn, green for Beveridge, yellow for Magnay)
