**RE: Nationally Consistent Collection of Data for School Students with a Disability**

Every year, all schools in Australia participate in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The NCCD process requires schools to identify information already available in the school about additional supports provided to students with disability. These relate to legislative requirements under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* and the *Disability Standards for Education in 2005*, in line with the *NCCD guidelines*.

Information provided about students to the Australian Government for the NCCD includes:

- Year of schooling
- Category of disability: physical, cognitive, sensory or social / emotional
- Level of adjustment provided: support provided within quality differentiated teaching practices, supplementary, substantial or extensive supports.

This information assists schools to:

- Recognise the supports and adjustments provided to students with disabilities within the school
- Evaluate the support practices within the school and consider how they may be strengthened
- Develop shared practices among staff, so that learning programs can be reviewed in order to improve educational outcomes for students with disability.

The NCCD provides state and federal governments with the information they need to plan for the support of students with disability, in schools and post-schooling. It will have no direct impact on your child as no identifiable data will be extracted in this data collection process. All information is protected by the privacy laws that regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information.
